All works must be the original works of the exhibitor with the name, address, title and if local subject printed on the back, with price or NFS. Any exhibits sold at the show will have 10% deducted by the P. A. & H. Society.

**All exhibits must be framed and ready to hang.**

**Entries close 5pm Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> March; no work will be accepted after this time.**

ENTRY FEE: 50c

PRIZE MONEY: First \$2, Second \$1.

**Specific Categories:**

1. Works on Paper – Chalk Pastel, Oil Pastel, Water Colour, Pen & Ink, Pencil Variety
2. Oil and Acrylic – Any Subject
3. Abstract and semi Abstract – Any Media
4. Miniature – Any medium – 10cm x 10cm painting size
5. Other – Sculpture, 3d Models, Pottery, and other items deemed suitable for Fine Art exhibition.
6. Local Subject – any medium – within the Snowy Valleys Council
7. Portrait – Local Identity – any medium

Exhibits entered in an inappropriate category may be moved to another category, excluded from Judging or not hung, at the discretion of the Stewards.

**Awards:** There will be award certificates for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in all categories where there is more than six entries. Commended, Highly Commended or Encouragement may be awarded.

**Champion:** Will Champion Exhibit in Fine Arts

**Local Subject Award:** Roy McClelland Award, The most original subject relating to Tumbarumba any media e.g. Sport, Industry, Events, Tourism etc.

**Encouragement Award:** Will receive a certificate

**People's Choice Award:** There will be provisions for voting a People's Choice of the Exhibition with the artist with the most votes receiving a gift voucher.
