The Tumbarumba P A & H Society host the Annual Tumbarumba Show on the third Saturday of March each and every year.

SITE FEES/GROUND SPACE

Car Boot Stall sites \$10

Power Points \$10 per power point for stalls

Stall caravans \$10 per day per van

Applications for car boot stalls must be lodged with the secretary seven (7) days prior to the show date.

Please report to the office upon arrival near the main entrance and you will be allocated your space. Should you require extra space that has not been listed in your application we have the right to refuse this if none is available. If we have space available, you are required to pay the additional fee on the day.

Should you want to hand out any brochures or flyers, this must be done from with the stall site only.

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SET UP/OPENING TIMES

Set up from 7.00am on show day

Show opening times are 9.00am until 3.00pm on Sunday

Because we are restricting the movement of vehicles within the Showground you will need to check with the office to see if you are able to move.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

Car Boot stall holders are expected to ensure that their stall meets the requirements of all health and safety standards or you may not be permitted to trade. A committee member will visit your stall on the day to assess this.

Please be aware of all leads, power boards and electrical connections if using power.

CAR BOOT STALL SALES

By having a car boot stall you agree that you must not be selling items that are part of a business or commercial activity and should be items from your home and are personal items that you want to move on.

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HOUSEKEEPING

Car boot stall holders are responsible for keeping their stalls and the immediate surrounding area tidy and clear of rubbish. We have plenty of rubbish bins located around the Showground. Car boot stall holders are to leave the area they use in the same condition as they find it. A breach of this may result in a penalty fee for rubbish removal and refusal of attendance at future events.

LIABILITY

The Tumbarumba PA & H Society accepts no responsibility to the Car boot stall holder's equipment, produce, materials or machinery for damage arising from:

- Theft and breakages
- Flooding, water, storm
- Electrical failure
- Malicious activities

CAR BOOT STALL PRESENTATION

We hope to provide a fun family day out for our visitors and as such we would like to create a colorful and festive atmosphere at our event. Car boot stall holders are encouraged to present their stalls in this manner to reflect our vision.

Camping tents are not to be used as part of a stall as these are not suitable. Visual appearance is important to us.

The use of loudspeakers, amplifiers and loud music is NOT permitted in any way.

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POSITIONING OF STALLS

Car boot stalls will be allocated at the discretion of the Committee. Please be aware that any requests for preferred positioning may not be granted. You will be notified of your position when you arrive and register at the office – near to the main gate entrance.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

The Annual Tumbarumba Show is held on the third Saturday of March each year. This is the start of autumn for us in the area and sometimes the weather can be a little unpredictable. We can still have some very warm days with temperatures in the high 20's or it can be a rainy day.

Car boot stall holders are asked to come prepared for any weather and have a wet weather contingency plan for your stall to protect your saleable items.

There is no alternative date for the Tumbarumba Show.

- I understand that my application does no guarantee me a car boot stall at the Tumbarumba Show until I have received approval.
- There will be no refunds if the event is cancelled for any reason within 7 days.
- Entry to the event may be refused if fees have not been paid in full prior to the event.
- The Tumbarumba P A & H Society will not be held responsible for loss or lack of income generated at the event, or if pre-held expectations have not been met.
- By applying for a car boot stall to trade or open at the Tumbarumba Show you agree to operate for the duration of the event on each day.
- Late requests made on the day of the event for power or location etc may be refused.
- You agree that any damage caused by you, your family or visitors at the venue is your responsibility.
- You cannot share a car boot stall with another stall holder or sell items on someone else's behalf.
- Car boot stalls cannot be transferred, sublet or franchised to another person without the Committee's approval.
- Any car boot stall holder who is found to be confronting another car boot stall holder for any reason will not be invited back to our event; we will not tolerate this type of behavior.
- Car boot stall holders must confine their displays to their allocated space. This includes all signs and displays. Please keep walkways free from clutter.
- Car boot stall holders are requested to stay until they event has closed if you need to use a vehicle to exit. This is for the safety of all visitors we may have.
- The Committee has the right to withdraw an offer to hold a car boot stall at our event and will not accept responsibility for any costs incurred.
